# How to use the RFC squash leagues website 3rd June 2018

#### Introduction


Here is a brief description of the new squash league system, which is accessed via URL: <a href="http://wimbledonracquets.leaguemaster.co.uk/">http://wimbledonracquets.leaguemaster.co.uk/</a>. Here is what the home page looks like:




#### How to access the system

If you are currently playing in the squash leagues then you will already be set up on the new system and should have received an email advising you of your user name and password. If you are not currently playing in the leagues you will need to register – c.f. next section.

The first time you log in to the system you will be asked to confirm that you are happy with our policy for managing your personal data in relation to the squash leagues:




Once you have logged in you will see this screen:



## How to register if you are a new player

Click on the "Registration" option on the home page and fill in the form to provide your contact details.



The purpose of the "security code" is to stop non members of the club registering. At the moment the security code is "WRFC" so just enter that in the required box. This may change from time to time and the latest code may always be obtained from reception at the club.

## Viewing the leagues


You can see the current leagues without having to log in by clicking on the "Box leagues" menu option on the home page.

There are two leagues set up "Team Leagues", which is what used to be called "Tom John", and "Club Leagues", which encompass Gold, Silver and Bronze leagues. Promotion rules for these leagues are slightly different – cf the league rules, which are accessed via the **Rules** menu option.

Note that no contact details are shown unless you log in – anyone with the url can view the leagues, but you need to be logged in to see phone numbers and email addresses.

## Arranging matches and managing results

Login, then click on "Box Leagues" and select the league you play in (Team Leagues or Club Leagues). You will then see a screen like this:



From this screen you can do everything you need to manage your league matches:

- Arrange matches by using the contact details shown for your opponents
- Enter a result by clicking on the appropriate match on the right hand side
- Amend a previously entered result by clicking on the appropriate match on the right hand side.
- Post a note which is visible to the other players in your league, e.g. if you are injured or away and can't play.

#### Changing your password and other personal details

Log in then select the "Profile" option. You can then change your password or update your contact details.
